

Melbet vs 22Bet: Detailed Comparison

Melbet vs 22Bet compared in 2026 — bonuses, cricket coverage, casino, app quality and odds. Which bookmaker offers more value for South Asian players.

TL;DR Melbet and 22Bet are close rivals for Indian and South Asian bettors: both run on a Curacao licence, both go heavy on cricket and esports, and both keep a low entry point with crypto and UPI in the cashier. They feel similar because they chase the same value-minded player; the differences sit in the detail. Melbet, live since 2012, leans on a dense live board, esports coverage and a busy promotions calendar, with a well-regarded Android APK. 22Bet matches it on market breadth and feels a touch cleaner for newcomers. This comparison breaks down licensing, sports and casino, bonuses and apps. Reconfirm the current offer on the official site first. 18+, play responsibly.

Licensing and coverage

Both Melbet and 22Bet operate under an international Curacao eGaming licence and serve Indian and South Asian players, with strong cricket coverage and a popular Android route to access.

Start with the foundation, because licensing shapes everything that follows. Both Melbet and 22Bet hold an international Curacao eGaming licence rather than a local Indian permit, which is how the bulk of offshore bookmakers operate for this region. Melbet has been live since 2012, giving it a long track record under Pelican-era ownership and a familiar name among South Asian bettors.

Coverage is where the two look almost identical from a distance. Each is built around cricket — IPL and international fixtures front and centre — alongside football, kabaddi and esports. For an Indian audience that mix is the whole point, and neither leaves obvious gaps in the calendar that matters most here.

- **Licensing:** both run on a Curacao international licence; neither holds a local Indian licence.
- **Regional access:** both are popular in India via the Android APK and mobile web; players use the current working address when needed.
- **Coverage focus:** cricket (IPL, international), football, kabaddi and esports on both.

The practical read: on regulation and regional fit they are level. Whichever you pick, set deposit limits early and treat any offshore account as one where verification (KYC) before withdrawal is the norm.

Same Curacao licence, same India-first cricket coverage — on the basics, Melbet and 22Bet are evenly matched.

Sports and casino

Both pair a broad sportsbook with a full casino. Melbet has the slightly denser live board and esports menu; 22Bet keeps pace across cricket, football and the headline casino titles.

On the sportsbook, the family resemblance is obvious. Both cover a wide spread of disciplines with cricket leading the way, then football, kabaddi, tennis, basketball and esports. If you bet mainstream cricket and football, you will not feel short-changed on either. Melbet leans on its experience with a dense in-play board, live streaming and cash-out on qualifying selections; 22Bet runs a solid live section over the same key fixtures, though Melbet typically lists a few more secondary markets per match.

The casino side is fully stocked on both: slots, live-dealer tables, and the crash-style games Indian players gravitate to, with Aviator a headline draw. Melbet's casino and live-casino lobbies are well built and easy to reach from the same account as the sportsbook, so you are not juggling two products.

- **Sports breadth:** cricket, football, kabaddi, tennis, basketball and esports on both.
- **Live betting:** Melbet edges it on in-play depth and refresh frequency; both offer cash-out and live streaming.
- **Casino:** slots, live casino and crash games including Aviator are available on each.

For an in-play and esports bettor, Melbet's board is the more rewarding to dig into. For pre-match cricket and a quick spin in the casino, the two are effectively interchangeable.

Breadth ties across sports and casino; Melbet pulls slightly ahead on live-betting and esports depth.

Bonuses

Both run a first-deposit welcome match plus rolling promotions. The headline figure matters less than the wagering terms, so always check the current offer on the official site.

Bonuses are where most comparisons begin, and both brands play the same game: a first-deposit match to stretch your opening bankroll. For the Indian market the exact cap and wagering rules shift with promotions and your account region, so the reliable move is to read the offer on the official site at sign-up rather than trust any fixed amount quoted elsewhere.

What is worth comparing is the structure. A high headline figure with heavy rollover can be worth less than a smaller offer you can actually clear. Look at the wagering multiple, the minimum odds you must bet at, and the deadline to complete it. Melbet also runs a busier ongoing calendar — reloads, accumulator boosts and cashback — which for a regular bettor often outweighs a one-time welcome match.

- **Welcome offer:** both use a first-deposit match (up to a 100% bonus is typical); confirm the exact INR cap on the official site.
- **Wagering:** both attach a rollover with minimum-odds and time limits — this decides the real value.
- **Ongoing promotions:** Melbet's reload, acca-boost and cashback calendar is the slightly deeper of the two.

For most bettors the long-term promotions matter more than the headline welcome figure. Bonus terms change frequently, so reconfirm on the official Melbet site before depositing, and never chase a bonus beyond your budget.

Judge the bonus by its wagering terms, not the headline number; Melbet has the deeper ongoing promotions calendar.

Apps and features

Both ship native Android and iOS apps plus a full mobile site. Melbet is feature-dense with one-click betting; 22Bet feels a little cleaner for first-timers.

Mobile is the default way most Indian bettors play, and both operators take it seriously. Each offers a native Android APK — downloaded directly from the site rather than the Play Store, as is normal for the category — plus an iOS app and a responsive mobile web version that needs no install. Melbet's APK is one of its calling cards for this market.

On features the two diverge in personality more than capability. Melbet packs a lot on screen: full access to line and live, one-click betting, and direct routes into the casino and Aviator from the same app. That density suits power users but can feel busy at first. 22Bet leans cleaner and more spacious, which tends to suit a bettor placing their first few wagers.

- **Android:** direct APK download on both; Melbet's is well established for Indian players.
- **iOS and web:** native iOS app plus full mobile web on each.
- **Features:** Melbet offers one-click betting, live streaming and in-app casino/Aviator; 22Bet keeps a cleaner, simpler layout.

Try both mobile sites before committing — you do not need to install anything to get a feel for the layout. The right one is simply the interface you find faster to navigate.

Feature parity on platforms; Melbet for power users who want everything in one app, 22Bet for a cleaner first run.

Verdict

Pick Melbet for live betting, esports and a deeper promotions calendar; pick 22Bet

for a cleaner interface on the same broad base. Many bettors keep both to line-shop.

After the detail, the choice comes down to how you bet rather than a single objective winner. The two share a Curacao licence, India-first cricket coverage, a full casino and crypto/UPI cashiers, so you will be well served by either. The tie-breakers are interface feel, live-betting depth and how much you value the ongoing promotions.

- **Best for casual and pre-match bettors:** 22Bet, for its cleaner, easier-to-scan layout.
- **Best for in-play and esports fans:** Melbet, for its denser live board, wider secondary markets and busier promotions calendar.
- **Best for value hunters:** hold both and compare the exact odds before each bet.

If you mostly bet pre-match cricket and want simplicity, start with 22Bet. If you live on the in-play board, follow esports, or want the fullest promotions calendar plus a strong Android app, Melbet is the stronger fit. Whichever you choose, confirm the current bonus and payment terms on the official site, set a deposit limit, and keep it fun. 18+, gambling involves financial risk — play responsibly.

Casual cricket bettors lean 22Bet; in-play, esports and bonus-hunters lean Melbet — or keep both and shop the line.

FAQ

Is Melbet or 22Bet better for Indian players?

Neither is a clear winner because they share a Curacao licence, strong cricket coverage and a low entry point with UPI and crypto. Melbet has the edge on live betting, esports and ongoing promotions plus a well-known Android APK, while 22Bet feels a little cleaner for newcomers. Pick on the feature that matters most to you.

Do Melbet and 22Bet have the same welcome bonus?

Both run a first-deposit match welcome offer, often up to a 100% bonus, but the exact INR cap and wagering terms are set per market and change with promotions. Always read the current offer on the official site at sign-up rather than rely on a fixed figure, and check the rollover before you commit.

Are Melbet and 22Bet legal and safe in India?

Both operate under an international Curacao eGaming licence rather than a local Indian licence, which is how most offshore bookmakers serve this region. Each provides responsible-gaming tools such as deposit limits and self-exclusion. Read recent reviews, verify your account early and only bet what you can afford. 18+, gambling involves risk; play responsibly.

Which has better cricket coverage, Melbet or 22Bet?

Both put cricket front and centre, covering IPL and international fixtures in depth, so for mainstream cricket they are closely matched. Melbet tends to list a few more in-play and secondary markets per match, which can matter if you bet live. For pre-match cricket the two are effectively interchangeable.

Can I download both the Melbet and 22Bet apps on Android?

Yes. Both offer a direct Android APK download from their official site rather than via Google Play, which is standard for the category. Melbet also provides an iOS app and a full mobile web version. Only download the APK from the official source, and keep it updated for security and the latest features.
