

Melbet vs Betwinner: Detailed Comparison

Melbet vs Betwinner compared in 2026 — bonuses, cricket, casino, app quality and odds. How these two similar sister-brand bookmakers actually differ.

TL;DR Melbet and Betwinner are close relatives in the international betting world, so choosing between them is more about small preferences than one clearly winning. Both run on a Curacao licence, both cover cricket, football, esports and a full casino with Aviator, and both let you start with a tiny deposit in INR. Melbet is popular with Indian players for its cricket depth and crypto-friendly cashier; Betwinner is liked for a clean app and steady promo rotation. Welcome offers and wagering terms change often, so reconfirm the current deal on the official site first. This guide compares the two on brand model, sports and casino, bonuses and apps so you can pick the right fit. 18+ only; play responsibly.

Brand overview

Both Melbet and Betwinner operate under a Curacao licence with a near-identical international model, covering South Asia, Africa and beyond from a multi-currency platform.

The reason these two feel so similar is that they share the same operating template. Both hold an international Curacao eGaming licence, both run as combined sportsbook-plus-casino platforms, and both target a global audience rather than a single regulated market. For an Indian bettor that means familiar ground on either site: cricket front and centre, INR support, local payment rails and an Android APK that does the heavy lifting.

Regional coverage overlaps heavily. Each brand is widely used across South Asia and Africa, leans on the same kind of crypto and e-wallet cashier to work around banking friction, and adapts the sports board to local tastes. The shared model is good news for you: switching between them carries almost no learning curve, and you can hold accounts on both to line up odds or claim whichever welcome offer reads better at the time.

One thing worth keeping in perspective is what a Curacao licence actually gives you. It allows the operator to run legally as an international book, but it is a lighter regime than the strict national regulators you find in some markets, so dispute resolution and player protections lean more on each operator own policies. That is true of Melbet and Betwinner equally, so it does not separate them, but it should shape how you treat both: read the terms, keep records, and never deposit money you are not prepared to lose.

- **Licence:** both run on a Curacao international eGaming licence.
- **Model:** bookmaker plus full online casino, multi-currency, global reach.
- **Coverage:** strong presence across South Asia and Africa, with INR and local payments for India.

Same licence, same combined sportsbook-casino model and overlapping regional coverage mean the two brands are more alike than different.

Sports and casino

Both cover cricket, football, kabaddi and esports plus a full casino with live tables and Aviator; Melbet tends to carry the deeper niche and cricket market board.

On core coverage the two are matched. Cricket anchors both boards for the Indian audience, with IPL and international fixtures sitting alongside football, kabaddi, tennis and a strong esports section. If you stick to the major sports you will find everything you need on either platform, including outright markets and a full set of pre-match and live options with cash out.

The separation shows in the niche layer. Melbet is known for stretching into smaller competitions and a wider spread of in-match cricket and esports markets, which helps if you follow leagues outside the spotlight. Betwinner covers the same headline sports thoroughly, but bettors hunting obscure markets sometimes find a slightly fuller board on Melbet. The practical test is to open the same mid-week fixture on each site and count the markets.

Casino is a real category on both, not an afterthought. Expect slots, live dealer tables and crash titles, with Aviator available on each. The same single account moves between sportsbook and casino, so you can switch without re-funding. A word of caution that applies to both: crash games like Aviator are fast, high-variance and easy to chase, so treat them as entertainment and set a hard limit before you start. Neither brand has an edge here that changes the maths in your favour.

For mainstream cricket, football and casino either book delivers; for niche markets and deeper in-match cricket lines, Melbet tends to edge ahead.

Bonuses

Both advertise a welcome bonus and rotating promos, but terms change constantly, so judge an offer by its wagering requirement rather than the headline figure.

Both brands offer a welcome bonus for new sign-ups along with ongoing promotions. Because these change frequently and vary by country, this guide will not quote a fixed amount. For Melbet, expect a first-deposit offer with the exact cap shown on the official site; Betwinner runs a comparable welcome deal. Always reconfirm the current terms before depositing, since bonus details shift often.

The number that decides whether an offer is worth claiming is the wagering requirement: how many times you must turn over the bonus before withdrawing. A larger headline bonus with a

steep playthrough can be worse than a smaller one with friendly terms. Watch the minimum-odds rule, the eligible-markets list and the expiry window too, because those quietly sink many bonus claims.

A useful way to think about a bonus is that it is not free money, it is a discount on the house edge that you only unlock by betting. If the conditions push you into long-odds accumulators you would never normally place, the offer can cost you more than it returns. Work out roughly how much you would have to stake to clear it, and only opt in if that turnover matches how you would bet anyway. Both brands also run ongoing promotions for existing players, but none of that should be a reason to deposit more than you planned.

- **Melbet welcome bonus:** a first-deposit offer; exact cap and terms on the official site.
- **Betwinner welcome bonus:** a comparable sign-up offer; verify the current deal before depositing.
- **Wagering:** read the turnover multiplier, minimum-odds requirement and time limit before opting in.

Both have a welcome bonus; the deciding factor is the wagering requirement and minimum-odds rule, so check current terms on the official site.

Apps and features

Both ship a direct Android APK and an iOS app with full betting features and one-click betting; Betwinner is often cleaner for newcomers, Melbet more information-dense.

Mobile is where most bets are placed, so the app matters. Both Melbet and Betwinner provide an Android app as a direct APK download from the official site (not via the Play Store) plus an iOS app, each carrying the same markets, live betting, cash out and one-click betting you get on desktop. There is no second-class mobile experience here; you can run your whole account from a phone.

On feel, the two differ in density. Betwinner often gets the nod for a cleaner, more guided layout that suits newer bettors. Melbet fits a lot onto each screen, which power users like but can feel busy at first. One-click betting is on both for fast repeat staking. Because the Android apps are APK-based, you must allow installs from unknown sources, so download only from the official source to stay safe.

Why not the Play Store? Google restricts real-money gambling apps in many regions, which is why both brands distribute Android through a direct APK instead. That is normal for this kind of operator, but it puts the safety burden on you: only ever grab the file from the brand official site, check it updates cleanly, and turn off unknown-source installs again once you are done. iOS users get an App Store route in supported regions, with the same markets and features as Android.

- **App quality:** both stable with full feature parity to desktop; Betwinner cleaner, Melbet denser.
- **APK download:** direct from the official site on both; enable unknown sources and install only from the official source.
- **One-click betting:** available on both for quick repeat bets.

Both apps cover Android (APK) and iOS with one-click betting and full features; pick Betwinner for a cleaner flow or Melbet for a denser interface.

Verdict

Choose Melbet for cricket depth, niche markets and crypto; choose Betwinner for a cleaner app and broader promo rotation. For mainstream low-stakes betting, either is fine.

The honest difference between these sister-style brands is small. They share a Curacao licence, the same combined sportsbook-casino model and overlapping coverage, so the winner is whichever lines up with your habits rather than whichever has a flashier homepage. Run a short checklist: what do you bet on, how do you want to fund the account, and which interface feels right in your hands?

What to choose comes down to emphasis. Melbet suits the bettor who wants deeper cricket and niche markets, a crypto-friendly cashier and a feature-packed app. Betwinner suits the player who values a tidy, beginner-friendly interface and a wider rotation of promotions. There is also a valid third option: keep both, since sign-up is cheap and holding two accounts lets you line-shop the better price on any bet.

- **Differences between brands:** mostly interface feel and niche-market depth, not licence or core features.
- **Pick Melbet** for cricket and niche depth, crypto funding and a dense, powerful app.
- **Pick Betwinner** for a cleaner app and broader promo variety.

Recommendation: both run on a Curacao licence, which offers lighter consumer protection than top-tier regulators, so weigh that up. Whichever you choose, set deposit limits, treat betting as entertainment, reconfirm bonus terms on the official site, and remember it is strictly 18+.

Match the book to your habits: Melbet for cricket and niche depth, Betwinner for app polish and promos, or keep both to line-shop; bet within limits and only if 18+.

FAQ

Are Melbet and Betwinner the same company?

They are not officially confirmed as one company, but they share a near-identical model, both run on a Curacao licence and offer very similar sportsbooks, casinos and apps, which is why players often call them sister brands.

Which is better for cricket betting in India?

Both cover IPL and international cricket well, but Melbet tends to carry the deeper board of in-match and niche cricket markets. For mainstream match-winner and totals bets the two are very close, so it is worth comparing the same fixture on each.

Do Melbet and Betwinner have similar bonuses?

Both offer a welcome bonus for new players and ongoing promotions. The amounts and wagering terms change often and differ by country, so check the current offer on the official

site and focus on the wagering requirement rather than the headline figure.

Can I download both apps on Android and iOS?

Yes. Both provide a direct Android APK from their official site and an iOS app, each with full betting features and one-click betting. For Android you must allow installs from unknown sources, so download only from the official source.

Are Melbet and Betwinner safe and licensed?

Both operate under a Curacao eGaming licence, which offers lighter consumer protection than top-tier regulators. Weigh that up, gamble responsibly, set deposit limits, and remember betting is strictly for those aged 18 and over.
