

Melbet vs Parimatch: Detailed Comparison

Melbet vs Parimatch compared in 2026 — bonuses, cricket coverage, casino, app quality and odds. Which bookmaker to choose in India and South Asia.

TL;DR Melbet and Parimatch both chase Indian and South Asian punters, but they pull in different directions. Melbet is an international Curacao-licensed bookmaker built around a huge betting line, a packed casino, crash titles like Aviator, and an Android APK that cricket bettors lean on. Parimatch is the more polished, marketing-heavy brand with a cleaner app and strong regional sponsorship, but a narrower secondary line. If you want depth, market count and a big casino under one roof, Melbet usually wins. If you prefer a streamlined interface and a recognisable name, Parimatch appeals. Bonus amounts shift often, so check each official site. 18+ only; gambling carries financial risk.

Licensing and coverage

Both run on international licensing rather than a local Indian permit. Melbet holds a Curacao eGaming licence; Parimatch operates internationally too, so for Indian players the practical difference is small.

Melbet has operated since 2012 under a Curacao (international eGaming) licence and positions itself as an international bookmaker plus online casino. That licence is what lets it accept players across Europe, Asia and the CIS, and it is the same framework Indian cricket bettors rely on when they sign up. Parimatch is also an internationally licensed brand with a long history and heavy sponsorship presence across South Asia, which gives it strong name recognition even where neither holds a domestic Indian licence.

For players in India and South Asia, the regulatory reality is similar: you are using an offshore operator, so the things that actually matter are payment support, account verification (KYC) and dispute handling rather than a local seal. Melbet leans into the cricket and Android APK audience, while Parimatch trades on brand familiarity. Neither is a substitute for checking what is permitted where you live before depositing.

- Melbet: Curacao international eGaming licence, active since 2012.
- Parimatch: international licensing, strong regional brand and sponsorship footprint.
- Both: offshore for Indian players, so KYC and payouts matter more than the badge.
- Currency support for the region is shown in INR on the official sites.

If reliability of access is your concern, both brands face the same blocking and mirror dynamics common to offshore bookmakers, and both publish their current working addresses on their official channels.

On licensing the two are close; pick on payouts, verification and access rather than the

licence badge alone.

Sports and casino

Melbet generally offers the wider betting line and the bigger casino, including crash games. Parimatch focuses on a tighter, well-presented selection across its core sports.

This is where the brands separate most clearly. Melbet runs a deep sportsbook with cricket front and centre for the Indian market (IPL and international fixtures), plus football, kabaddi and esports, alongside live betting and live streaming. On top of that sits a large casino with live tables and crash titles, including Aviator, all inside the same account. That breadth is Melbet's main pitch: one balance covering pre-match, in-play, slots and crash games.

Parimatch covers the headline sports competently and presents them in a cleaner interface, but its secondary and niche markets are usually shallower than Melbet's, and its casino, while solid, tends to feel more curated than sprawling. For a punter who only bets cricket and football majors, the gap narrows; for someone who wants obscure markets, deep esports or a big crash and slots library, Melbet has the edge.

Both support live betting and one-click betting, so the in-play experience is comparable for mainstream events. The real differentiator is depth and casino scale, where Melbet is the more maximalist option.

Choose Melbet for line depth and a bigger casino; Parimatch if a tidy core selection matters more than market count.

Bonuses

Both run a first-deposit welcome offer for new players, but exact amounts and wagering terms change often, so the headline figure matters less than the rollover conditions.

Melbet advertises a first-deposit welcome bonus of up to a 100% match, with the exact INR cap shown on the official site rather than fixed here. Parimatch also runs a welcome offer for new accounts in the region. Because both brands adjust promotions frequently and by geo, the smartest move is to read the live terms on each official site at sign-up rather than trust any

third-party number that may be out of date.

What actually decides value is not the percentage but the conditions attached: the wagering (rollover) multiplier, the minimum odds that count toward it, the time limit, and which products (sports vs casino) the bonus can be cleared on. A larger headline bonus with a harsh rollover can be worth less than a smaller one with fair terms.

- Melbet: up to a 100% first-deposit bonus; exact cap and terms on the official site.
- Parimatch: a comparable new-player welcome offer for the region.
- Check the wagering multiplier and qualifying minimum odds before depositing.
- Note the time window and whether the bonus is sports-only, casino-only or both.
- Both frequently run reload, cashback and free-bet style promotions for existing players.

Treat any welcome offer as a small head start, not a reason to bet more than you planned. 18+ only, and never chase a bonus with money you cannot afford to lose.

Compare wagering terms, not headline percentages, and confirm the live offer on each official site before you deposit.

Apps and features

Parimatch is known for a polished, streamlined app, while Melbet offers a feature-dense Android APK and iOS app plus a mobile site, favouring functionality over minimalism.

Mobile is central for both, and they take different design philosophies. Melbet provides an Android APK (installed from the official site rather than the Play Store), an iOS app and a mobile web version, all carrying the full sportsbook, casino, crash games, live betting, live streaming and one-click betting. The trade-off is that the interface is busier because it is doing more. Parimatch's app is generally cleaner and faster to navigate, which suits players who want to place a bet quickly without wading through options.

Shared, useful features on both sides include cash out (full and partial on eligible bets), live betting, and 24/7 support via live chat. Melbet's broader feature set, including its larger casino and crash library inside the same app, is the practical reason heavier users gravitate to it; Parimatch's restraint is the reason casual bettors often prefer it.

1. Melbet Android: download the APK from the official site and allow installation from unknown sources.
2. Melbet iOS: install via the official iOS route shown on the site.
3. Parimatch: install the app from its official distribution channel for your region.
4. Both: log in once and access sports, live betting and cash out from the same balance.

If you value a clean, quick interface, Parimatch is the smoother daily driver. If you want every product in one app, Melbet's density is a feature rather than a flaw.

Pick Parimatch for a cleaner app, Melbet for an all-in-one app with the full casino and crash library built in.

Verdict

Melbet wins on breadth, casino size and feature count; Parimatch wins on polish and brand familiarity. The right pick depends on whether you want depth or a tidy experience.

Both brands are credible offshore options for Indian and South Asian players, and both centre cricket, mobile play and INR support. The decision comes down to temperament. Melbet is the maximalist choice: more markets, a larger casino, crash games like Aviator, and a feature-packed app that rewards players who want everything in one place. Parimatch is the streamlined choice: a recognisable name, a cleaner interface and a confident core line, at the cost of some depth in niche markets and casino scale.

If you are a frequent bettor who mixes cricket, football, esports and casino, Melbet's range is hard to beat. If you mostly bet major events and prize a fast, uncluttered app, Parimatch is the easier daily experience. Either way, confirm current bonus terms, payment support and verification rules on the official site before depositing, and keep play within limits.

- Choose Melbet for: line depth, casino size, crash games and an all-in-one app.
- Choose Parimatch for: a polished interface and strong brand recognition.
- Both: solid cricket coverage, live betting, cash out and 24/7 live chat.
- Always: check live terms on the official site and set deposit limits.

Go Melbet for depth and casino scale, Parimatch for a clean app and familiar brand, and verify terms before you commit.

Both cover IPL and international cricket, but Melbet typically offers more side markets and a deeper line, while Parimatch presents its cricket cleanly with fewer niche options. Heavy cricket bettors usually prefer Melbet for depth; casual bettors may find Parimatch simpler.

Which one has the bigger welcome bonus?

Melbet advertises up to a 100% first-deposit bonus, with the exact INR cap on its official site, and Parimatch runs a comparable new-player offer. Amounts and wagering terms change often, so compare the live conditions on each official site rather than the headline figure.

Are Melbet and Parimatch legal for players in India?

Both operate on international licensing rather than a local Indian permit, so they function as offshore bookmakers. Rules vary by location, so check what is permitted where you live before signing up or depositing. Play responsibly and only if you are 18 or over.

Which app is easier to use?

Parimatch is generally the cleaner, faster app and suits players who want to bet quickly. Melbet packs more into its Android APK and iOS app, including the full casino and crash games,

so it feels busier but does more in one place.

Can I bet on both crash games like Aviator?

Melbet includes Aviator and other crash games alongside its casino in the same account. Parimatch crash and casino availability varies by region, so check its official site to confirm what is offered for your location.
